**Re: Mapping Update to Application for Site Plan Review
Maine Power Reliability Program
Central Maine Power Company**

Dear Planning Board Members:

This letter and the enclosed mapping serve to update Central Maine Power Company's (CMP) Application for Site Plan Review of the proposed Maine Power Reliability Program (MPRP) in the Town of Wales. On February 11, 2010 CMP submitted the MPRP Application for Site Plan Review in the Town of Wales (MPRP Application). On February 22, 2010, I notified Arthur Dunlap, the Wales Code Enforcement Officer (CEO), by telephone that minor modifications to the location of the proposed temporary access ways shown on the MPRP Application mapping have been made, and that CMP would submit updated mapping showing these changes. Updated mapping showing the revised MPRP temporary access way locations is enclosed with this letter. This mapping replaces the Project Scope and Natural Resources Maps that were provided as part of Exhibit 1 of the MPRP Application submitted on February 11, 2010.

Mr. Dunlap and I also briefly discussed the MPRP Site Plan Review Application fee during our telephone conversation. Article 2.5 of the Site Plan Review Ordinance states that a Site Plan Review Application will be accompanied by an application fee "as determined by the Selectmen in the Town's posted fee schedule". CMP was unable to provide the Site Plan Review Application Fee with the MPRP Application submitted on February 11, 2010 because the Town's fee schedule was not available. CMP requests that the Planning Board provide the Town's fee schedule via mail or email as soon as possible, so that CMP may submit the Site Plan Review application fee.

With regard to scheduling Planning Board review of the MPRP Application, it is CMP's understanding that, in accordance with Article 2.5 of the Site Plan Review Ordinance, the Code Enforcement Officer will make a "preliminary determination of completeness for Planning Board review" within 30 days of receipt of the MPRP Application. Accordingly, CMP anticipates that a preliminary determination of completeness will be made by March 13, 2010 at the latest. CMP requests written notification when a determination is made. CMP also understands that, in accordance with Article 2.5 of the Site Plan Review Ordinance, within 30 days of the Code Enforcement Officer's preliminary determination of completeness the MPRP will be placed on the Planning Board's agenda for consideration. According to the provisions described above, with a

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positive preliminary determination of completeness issued by the CEO, CMP anticipates that the MPRP will be placed on the Planning Board Agenda by no later than the April 12, 2010 Planning Board Meeting. CMP also requests written notification when the MPRP is placed on the Planning Board Agenda.
